- 1. Carefulness: Puts guardrails up not to sin
- 2. Clearing of Self: Experiences forgiveness
- 3. Indignation: Holy anger toward your sin
- 4. Fear: That you could do it again
- 5. Vehement Desire: Genuine desire to conquer sin
- 6. Zeal: Fervent mind to see victory, eager
- 7. Revenge: Wants to get back at the sin

CONCLUSION

- Sovereign repentance has to do with God's response to us.
- Sinner's repentance has to do with redemption.
- · Saint's repentance has to do with righteousness.




