To him be glory both now and for ever. Amen." (2 Peter 3:17-18)

A. From falling

THE POSSIBILITY OF FAILING

"And Jesus answering them began to say, Take heed lest any man deceive you:" (Mark 13:5)

many false teachers who deceive

"This second epistle, beloved, I now write unto you; in both which I stir up your pure minds by way of remembrance: 2 That ye may be mindful of the words which were spoken before by the holy prophets, and of the commandment of us the apostles of the Lord and Saviour:" (2 Peter 3:1-2)

THE PATH TO FAILURE

"I marvel that ye are so soon removed from him that called you into the grace of Christ unto another gospel: 7 Which is not another; but there be some that trouble you, and would pervert the gospel of Christ." (Galatians 1:6-7)

another gospel?

- Saying "Another Jesus" or "False Jesus" are all false gospels

"While they promise them liberty, they themselves are the servants of corruption: for of whom a man is overcome, of the same is he brought in bondage." (2 Peter 2:19)

Quote: "Grace does not grant permission to live in the flesh; it supplies power to live in the Spirit."

B. From steadfastness

HOW TO AVOID FALLING

1. Get Rooted Scripturally

"Rooted and built up in him, and established in the faith, as ye have been taught, abounding therein with thanksgiving. 8 Beware lest any man spoil you through philosophy and vain deceit, after the tradition of men, after the rudiments of the world, and not after Christ." (Colossians 2:7-8)

2. Keep a Clear Conscience

"Holding faith, and a good conscience; which some having put away concerning faith have made shipwreck:" (1 Timothy 1:19)

Quote: "Keep short accounts with God."

Quote: "True Christians cannot fall from salvation and be lost, but they can fall from their own 'steadfastness.'"

3. Continue in What You Have Been Taught

"But evil men and seducers shall wax worse and worse, deceiving, and being deceived. 14 But continue thou in the things which thou hast learned and hast been assured of, knowing of whom thou hast learned them;" (2 Timothy 3:13-14)

4. Seek God in Prayer

"For we have not an high priest which cannot be touched with the feeling of our infirmities; but was in all points tempted like as we are, yet without sin. 16 Let us therefore come boldly unto the throne of grace, that we may obtain mercy, and find grace to help in time of need." (Hebrews 4:15-16)

2. GRACE PRODUCES Strength

Quote: "Be constantly growing'. We should not grow in spurts, but in a constant experience of development."

"Wherefore laying aside all malice, and all guile, and hypocrisies, and envies, and all evil speakings, 2 As newborn babes, desire the sincere milk of the word, that ye may grow thereby: 3 If so be ye have tasted that the Lord is gracious." (1 Peter 2:1-3)

Quote: "Before we can learn the sufficiency of God's grace, we must learn the insufficiency of ourselves."

GRACE NURTURES TRUST IN GOD

"And lest I should be exalted above measure through the abundance of the revelations, there was given to me a thorn in the flesh, the messenger of Satan to buffet me, lest I should be exalted above measure. 8 For this thing I besought the Lord thrice, that it might depart from me. 9 And he said unto me, My grace is sufficient for thee: for my strength is made perfect in weakness. Most gladly therefore will I rather glory in my infirmities, that the power of Christ may rest upon me." (2 Corinthians 12:7-9)

GRACE PRODUCES PRAISE FOR GOD

"Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly in all wisdom; teaching and admonishing one another in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing with grace in your hearts to the Lord." (Colossians 3:16)

put God's word into Christian life

Quote: "God gave you about 23,000 breaths today – have you used even one of them to praise Him?"

GRACE PRODUCES A HEART TO GIVE TO GOD

"Moreover, brethren, we do you to wit of the grace of God bestowed on the churches of Macedonia; 2 How that in a great trial of affliction the abundance of their joy and their deep poverty abounded unto the riches of their liberality." (2 Corinthians 8:1-2)

giving money to help starving Christians in Jerusalem

B. Grow in knowledge

"That ye might walk worthy of the Lord unto all pleasing, being fruitful in every good work, and increasing in the knowledge of God;" (Colossians 1:10)

— Walk worthy in God's grace
* giving neighborly love

"Search the scriptures; for in them ye think ye have eternal life: and they are they which testify of me. 40 And ye will not come to me, that ye might have life." (John 5:39-40)

"Sanctify them through thy truth: thy word is truth." (John 17:17)

Quote: "Take 15 minutes each day to listen to God talking to you; take 15 minutes each day to talk to God; take 15 minutes each day to talk to others about God."

3. GRACE PRODUCES Service (v. 18b)

"And God is able to make all grace abound toward you; that ye, always having all sufficiency in all things, may abound to every good work:" (2 Corinthians 9:8)

Quote: "The supreme test of service is this: 'For whom am I doing this?'"—A. T. Pierson

A. Service for a person

LORD - Christ the Lord God

SAVIOR - Saved us from our sins

"The LORD is my light and my salvation; whom shall I fear? The LORD is the strength of my life; of whom shall I be afraid?" (Psalm 27:1)

B. Service for a purpose

NOW - in earthly life

FOREVER - in heaven

"Whether therefore ye eat, or drink, or whatsoever ye do, do all to the glory of God." (1 Corinthians 10:31)

"For ye are bought with a price; therefore glorify God in your body, and in your spirit, which are God's." (1 Corinthians 6:20)

3 WAYS TO GLORIFY GOD

1. Good Works

"Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works, and glorify your Father which is in heaven."
(Matthew 5:16)

2. Bearing Fruit

"Herein is my Father glorified, that ye bear much fruit; so shall ye be my disciples." (John 15:8)

3. Generous Giving

"For the administration of this service not only supplieth the want of the saints, but is abundant also by many thanksgivings unto God; 13 Whiles by the experiment of this ministration they glorify God for your professed subjection unto the gospel of Christ, and for your liberal distribution unto them, and unto all men;"
(2 Corinthians 9:12-13)
