## 1. Introduction

- a. Two disciples walking on road to Emmaus from Jerusalem
  - distance 60 stadia (Roman)
  - in American units 7 miles

### b. Names of travelers

- Cleopas (<sup>Cleopas</sup> LK 24:18)

\*Greek name meaning "glory to the father" - also Cleophas  
\*also mentioned in Jn 19:25 as husband to Mary, one of several women who went to Jesus' tomb in early Sunday AM

- second man unnamed

### c. Both men talking & reasoning together of recent events

## 2. Unknown Stranger

- a. Disciples' eyes did not recognize traveler joining them

- b. Third person asks them about their sad conversations

- c. Original 2 ask 3<sup>rd</sup> man how he could not have known about Jesus of Nazareth death

- they considered Jesus a prophet
- they had hoped that Jesus would deliver & redeem Israel

2d. Even Jesus original 12  
disciples hoped that for Jesus  
to redeem Israel  
- Acts 1:6 "Lord, will You at  
this time restore again the  
kingdom of Israel?"

3. Women at Empty Tomb
- a. Original 2 had already received the news of the empty tomb
  - Mary wife of Cleopas was one of the women at the tomb.  
(Jn 19:25)
  - b. Also Peter & John had seen empty tomb (Jn 20:2-9)

4. Jesus Teaches Two Followers
- a. Slow of heart to believe
    - Two on road to Emmaus (vs 25)
    - Disciples (Mt 16:11, 13)
  - b. Jesus teaches about the prophecies from the Old Testament of His sufferings & returning to His heavenly glory
  - c. In all this original 2 still did not recognize Jesus

5. At Emmaus During Lunch
- a. Jesus gives the blessing for the meal
  - b. Recognition
    - Jesus blessed the bread & broke it in pieces
    - Suddenly, the 2 had "eyes open" & recognized Jesus
  - c. Jesus vanished from their sight

6. Final report in Jerusalem
- a. Their hearts burned within as Jesus taught from Scriptures
  - b. They returned to Jerusalem & told eleven Disciples - "He is risen!"
