1. Introduction

a. In presence of God

b. Surrounded by heavenly beings

2. Consumed by God's Glory

a. Chap 1-5 Hope & judgement

- King Uzziah of Judea good king

- prosperity settled over Judea

- Several woes pronounced
against Israel

- pride & arrogance with
increasing wealth

b. God's grace is God's wrath

poured out on His only begotten
Son (Son of God/Son of Man)

c. Seraphim above God's throne

"Holy, holy, holy is the Lord of Hosts.
The whole earth full of His glory."

d. Isaiah saw God sitting on throne

- high & lifted up

3. Confronted by God's Holiness

a. Seraphim with 6 wings

- 2 wings cover their face

- 2 wings cover their feet

- 2 wings to fly

- 2/3 of wings to cover in
presence of Holy God

3b. God's holiness

- Exod 3:5 holy ground at burning bush "take off your shoes"
- Exod 33:18-20 Moses wanted to see God's glory
 - * "No man can see My face & live"

4. Convicted By Our Sin

- Isaiah sees God's glory & holiness
- First reaction: "I am a man of unclean lips"
 - * Because my eyes have seen the King the Lord of Hosts"
- Other reaction: "Woe is me because I am undone."
- See your own personal sin in God's presence of glory & holiness
 - John in Rev 1:17 John fell at resurrected Jesus feet
 - * as if he were dead
 - * John was so overwhelmed
- God's view of all human righteousness (Is 64:6)
 - all our righteousness are as filthy rags

5. But God Gives Hope

- Isaiah experience with God
 - Is 6:6-7 coal from God's altar
 - * Your iniquity is taken away. And your sin is purged.
- Sins forgiven offered to all
 - Is 1:18 "Come let us reason together"
 - * though your sins be as [red] scarlet
 - * though they be red like crimson
 - * God's action: to cover the sins to be as white as snow or white as [clean] wool
